



Crayons to Computers Early Childhood Program Ohio 2019-2020 Application

Crayons to Computers recognizes the importance of quality early childhood education in a student's academic development. Starting in 2013, we developed a partnership with 4C for Children to help evaluate and expand the Crayons to Computers Early Childhood Program. We continue to review and accept new qualifying programs on a yearly basis. Please see the criteria listed below for new applicants to this program. If your center meets these requirements, we invite you to apply to participate in our program.

Founded in 1997, Crayons to Computers is a nonprofit organization that addresses the critical need of providing classroom supplies to students and teachers throughout Greater Cincinnati. Through the Teacher Free Store and Mobile Outreach Program, we offer a variety of materials that support learning, including basic supplies like books, crayons, paper, scissors, and pencils as well as enrichment and incentive items that teachers can use to motivate and inspire student engagement. Crayons to Computers currently serves 450 Preschool through Grade 12 schools from 16 Ohio, Northern Kentucky, and Indiana counties. Since inception, Crayons to Computers has distributed over \$164 million worth of free educational materials, now serving more than 114,000 students each academic year.

If accepted into our program, the Director and other designated, eligible staff are permitted to shop at our Teacher Free Store up to 10 times a school year, which runs August through May. Shopping hours are: Monday – Thursday, 2:30 PM – 6:30 PM, and generally, the second and fourth Saturday of each month, 9:00AM – 2:00 PM.

To be considered, Ohio centers must:

- Serve preschool children (ages 3-5);
- Be located within the 16 counties currently served by Crayons to Computers;
- Accept state assistance from families who qualify to help them pay for childcare;
- Be in operation for at least 1 year;
- Be a Child Care Center OR Family Child Care Program that:
 - o Currently holds a quality (star) rating with Ohio's Step Up to Quality OR
 - o Is working with 4C for Children and actively in pursuit of a quality rating with Ohio's Step Up to Quality

Completed applications must be received by Friday, April 19, 2019 for consideration. Programs qualifying will be notified prior to the start of the 2019-2020 academic school year. Selected programs are required to attend an orientation program prior to shopping.
